Sheree is a fantastic teacher and will add a lot to the Tiramaroa team.

We have an action packed term planned. As we wrap up our New Zealand Histories learning over the next week our students will more into learning about Planet Earth and how it has changed over time (geology), find out about the continents of the world (geography) as well as taking a deep dive into looking at the amazing things New Zealand has to offer. We will also be using measurement and learning about our local history.

You may have noticed over the course of last term, a few more posts than normal from HERO. The purpose of these posts is to share a snapshot of the learning that is taking place in class over a variety of curriculum areas. 
