Term 3 Focus

Term Concept: Patterns

Major Curriculum Focus: Social Studies

Minor Curriculum Focus: New Zealand History



After a few weeks, we will start our new deep learning in Social Studies with a focus on the Economic World. We will be learning about Needs and Wants, Goods and Services, Consumers and Producers, and Spending and Saving. We look forward to our tamariki being financially savvy – and I am sure you will benefit from it too!

Following on from this, towards the end of the term, we will be looking at local economic history, stemming back from local iwi and the goods that were traded with other iwi, following on to the goods and services Rolleston provides in the current day.

Names!

A reminder that it is extremely important to name all clothing, so that it goes back to the original owner if lost. In these winter terms, students take off their outerwear when inside and it is very easy for another child to accidentally put on the wrong polar fleece or jacket at the end of the day. Please ensure that second-hand uniform is also updated with the correct name as well.

Before School
